NEXT GEN PIR NEW PUMP DEPLOYMENT!

PIR is an evolving standard owned and defined by Well Cell. Examples of this evolution include R&D programs with leading universities, a suite of newly pending patents and trade secret protections, and the launch of **Next Gen PIR!**

For some time, Well Cell has been working with, investigating, and testing pumps that physicians can use to implement the PIR treatment process. Well Cell's previous pump manufacturer notified us that they intended to do a "Voluntary product removal" of their pump. This voluntary removal was subsequently reclassified as a "Voluntary class 1 recall." Accordingly, Well Cell moved up its timeline to deploy Next Gen PIR. It selected a new approved pump and an alternate from two different manufacturers. The improvement in the new primary pump is substantial, and we are referring to this iteration as **Next Gen PIR**.

Next Gen PIR includes the transition to a cloud-based paperless environment and an unrivaled, state-of-the-art pump—improving the cost and efficiency of clinics deploying Next Gen PIR. The transition to Next Gen PIR permits continued use of your current device, based on your physician's determination not to disrupt essential care, until it reaches its end of life. All devices will need to be transitioned at that point, and updated license agreements will be forthcoming to facilitate this exciting jump forward!
